


This seven-year initiative was created by Canada’s Sports Hall of Fame in collaboration with Indigenous Hall of Famers and countless Indigenous, sport, museum and historical partners. The first of its kind educational exhibit, this initiative shares the stories of the 14 Indigenous Hall of Famers and brings awareness to their truths and experiences, which in turn, prompts conversation about equity and inclusion, through the lens of sport, to ultimately foster a more informed, united, inclusive and stronger Canada.
